ORDINANCE NO. 2016-010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.01 OF THE CASTLE ROCK MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW ARTICLE VIII INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM AND PROVIDING FOR PROCEDURES FOR REMOVAL OF SIGNATURES FROM A REFERENDUM OR INITIATIVE PETITION

WHEREAS, at the November 3, 2015 Special Election, voters approved an amendment to the Castle Rock Home Rule Charter to allow a registered elector to withdraw his or her signature from an initiative or referendum petition; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 15-1(c) and 15-2(c) of the Castle Rock Home Rule Charter, it is necessary to establish a procedure for a registered elector to have his or her signature withdrawn from a referendum or initiative petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Amendment</u>. Chapter 2.01 of the Castle Rock Municipal Code is hereby amended to add a new Article VIII – Initiative and Referendum, to read as follows:

Article VIII. Initiative and Referendum

2.01.800 Petition signature withdrawal.

A registered elector may request that his or her name be withdrawn from an initiative or referendum petition ("Petition") on or before the date the Petition is filed with the Town Clerk for a determination of Petition sufficiency. Such request shall be made as follows:

- A. The request for the withdrawal shall be in writing and contain the following information:
 - 1. Statement that the registered elector is requesting their signature be withdrawn from the Petition.
 - 2. Registered elector's name
 - 3. Registered elector's address
 - 4. Signature of elector
 - 5. Date of signature

B.	The request may be subm	itted to the Town	Clerk via email,	fax, regular r	nail, or hand
delivery.	If submitted by regular mail,	the request must	be postmarked	on or before	the date the
Petition is	submitted to the Town Clerk.	Requests by phon	e will not be acc	cepted.	

- **Section 4.** <u>Severability.</u> If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance.
- **Section 5.** <u>Safety Clause.</u> The Town Council finds and declares that this ordinance is promulgated and adopted for the public health, safety and welfare and this ordinance bears a rational relation to the legislative object sought to be obtained.
