



## IN HONOR OF THE CASTLE ROCK HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND MUSEUM'S CELEBRATION OF THE 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CASTLE ROCK DENVER & RIO GRANDE DEPOT



WHEREAS, we know history binds people together, shares our story and provides meaning to our world; and

**WHEREAS,** in 1875, the Castle Rock Denver & Rio Grande Railroad depot opened. It provided residents and travelers with convenient transportation to Denver and for rhyolite quarried in Castle Rock to be transported far and wide; and

**WHEREAS,** in 1996, the Castle Rock Historical Society purchased the Castle Rock depot, restored it and opened the Castle Rock Museum in the historic depot in 1997, at 420 Elbert St.; and

**WHEREAS,** the depot is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and in 2025, the Castle Rock Denver & Rio Grande Railroad depot is 150 years old;

**WHEREAS,** in honor of this milestone, the Castle Rock Historical Society and Museum is hosting a 150th anniversary celebration on Saturday, Sept. 6, 2025, at the Castle Rock Museum.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Castle Rock does hereby honor the Castle Rock Historical Society for maintaining and preserving the 1875 Castle Rock Denver & Rio Grande Railroad depot and operating the Castle Rock Museum, where history of the Castle Rock area is shared.
