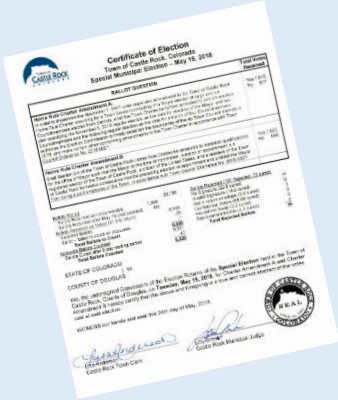

## Elections

The May 15, 2018 special election is complete. Amendment A passed setting the Mayor at Large election for November 6, 2018 and authorizing the Election Commission to redistrict from 7 to 6 districts. Amendment B passed outlining the qualifications for the Mayor at Large.

The Election Commission has completed their redistricting process using a “live” electronic redistricting solution which saved substantial time and effort for staff and the Election Commission. This process previously took up to 11 weeks to accomplish. The Election Commission met on May 30, 2018 to review and adjust the 2018 Election District Map and approved the 2018 Election District Map with the 2018 Redistricting Plan at their June 11, 2018 Election Commission Meeting. Both will be presented to Town Council at their June 19, 2018 Town Council meeting.

Candidates for the Mayor at Large and Councilmember Districts 3 and 5 can register with the Town Clerk at any time. Petitions to appear on the ballot may be circulated beginning August 7 and must be filed with the Town Clerk by August 27. The election for the Mayor and two Councilmembers will occur on November 6, 2018; and the newly elected members of Town Council will be sworn in at the December 4, 2018 Town Council meeting.

### Town History Trivia

***In honor of Police Week and my husband, Commander John Anderson  
Retiring from the Castle Rock Police department on May 17, 2018 after  
40 years of service to the citizens of Castle Rock***

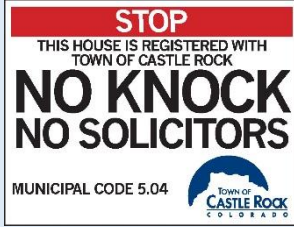
On April 7, 1942, Raymond Burr Lewis was elected as the Town Street Commissioner (Police). Marshal Ray Lewis was killed in the B&B Café at 4<sup>th</sup> and Wilcox on Valentine’s Day, February 14, 1946 by Manuel Perez, a 17-year-old fugitive eluding authorities in Castle Rock after shooting two Denver officers. Perez was sentenced to a life sentence and died in a prison knife fight.



Ray Lewis’ name was inscribed on the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, DC when the wall was dedicated in October 1991. Commander Anderson (Captain Anderson at that time) attended this historic ceremony; and as his last official act as a law enforcement officer, attended the ceremony along with members from the Castle Rock Police department and the Douglas County Sheriffs Office for the inscription of Deputy Zach Parish on that same wall on May 14, 2018.

Current Initiatives: Scanning is complete of all Town records dating back to 1881. The process to organize, index and analyze for retention requirements for these records will be an ongoing process.

Solicitors must register with the Town each year and may not knock on your door if you are on the No Knock list. If you are not registered, Solicitors may knock on your door; and there is currently no curfew/restriction on times that Solicitors can contact residents due to the outcome of the Aptive litigation.

No Knock stickers are mailed to the newly enrolled residents, and their addresses are added to the No Knock List which is published on the Town website.

# *Liquor Licensing*

Liquor licensing activity has increased as the Town continues to grow and attract new establishments in addition to existing businesses changing ownership. We anticipate approximately a 10% increase in Special events permits.

Current Initiatives: Propose an ordinance that will alter the 500-foot distance requirement to new schools built within business zones, and monitor legislation that impacts liquor laws such as special event holders and full strength beer sales at previously licensed 3.2% stores beginning in 2019.
