# FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4.04 - WATER DEDICATION - OF THE CASTLE ROCK MUNICIPAL CODE TO MAKE CHANGES NEEDED TO ALIGN WITH THE BUSINESS PRACTICES OF CASTLE ROCK WATER AND TO MAKE SOME ADMINISTRATIVE REVISIONS

### **OVERVIEW:**

- In addition to Town Council's authority, also allow the Director of Castle Rock Water, under special circumstances, to waive the requirement that groundwater be adjudicated prior to dedication;
- Allow Town Council or the Director, under special circumstances, to waive the requirement of a title opinion for the dedication of water;
- 3) Remove development credit for not-nontributary groundwater so a dedicator does not need to adjudicate a plan for augmentation prior to dedication; and
- 4) Require dedication of any tributary water rights associated with a property.

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### **DISCUSSION:**

- The definitions for groundwater rights and tributary rights were revised. And the definition of water rights was added.
- Credit for not-nontributary groundwater was removed.

 More flexibility was given with the Title Opinion requirement.



### **DISCUSSION:**

 Prior to dedication, adjudications and augmentation plans are no longer mandatory.

 All tributary water rights, associated with a property, must be conveyed to the Town.  Administrative revisions were made to clarify and correct some inaccuracies.
