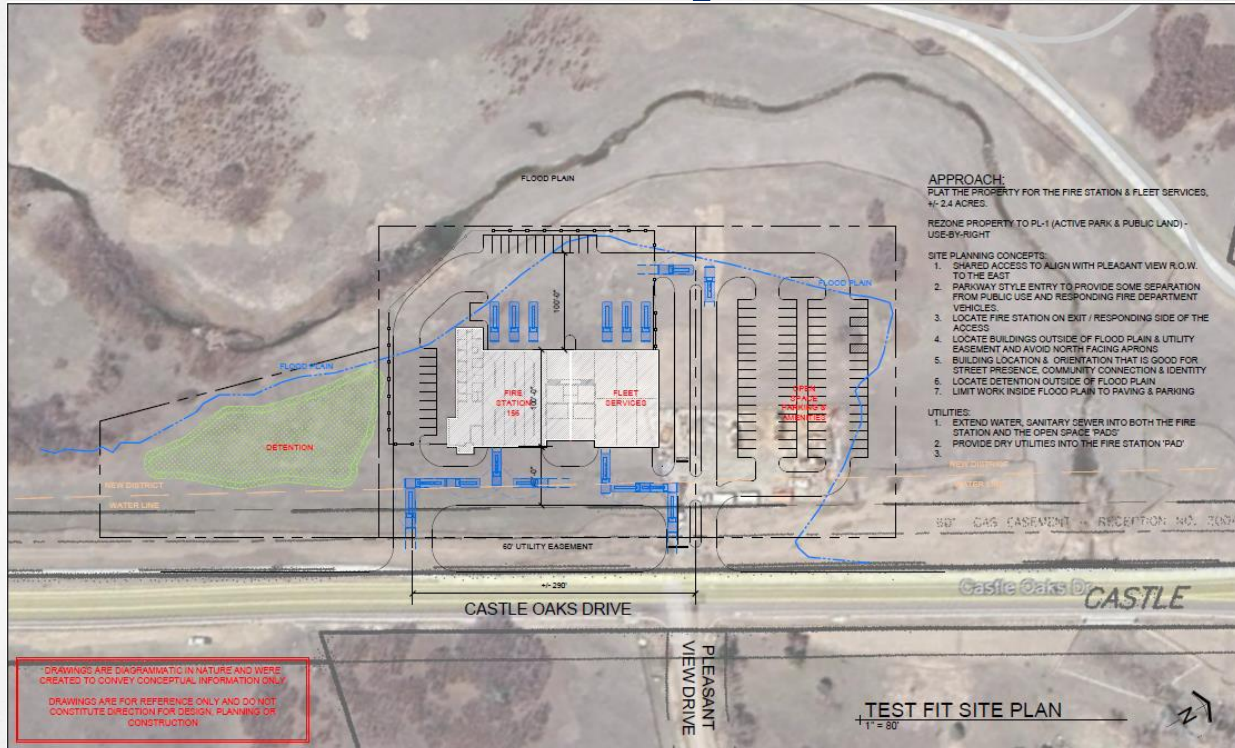
STATION 156 AND FLEET

- Terrain/Cobblestone Ranch service area (FMZ 6)
 - Site located at Castle Oaks Drive/Pleasant View Drive
 - Will also include Fleet Facility for apparatus repair and equipment storage
 - Co-located with Parks and Rec Parking Lot for trail access
- Has been identified in master plan as call volumes and response times have increased in this area
- Will be staffed with one engine and one brush truck (cross staffed)
 - Three personnel per shift
 - One lieutenant, one engineer, one firefighter/paramedic

ARCHITECT RFP

- Project was competitively bid
 - 8 submissions ranging in cost from \$714,930 to \$1,147,845
 - Interviewed two – RS&H and Short Elliott Hendrickson (SEH) [architect for Station 152]
- Team selected RS&H
 - Was also the low bidder
- Requesting approval to contract with RS&H for architectural and engineering services for Fire Station 156 and Fleet Facility.

RS&H

- Formerly known as HB&A
- Has performed other work for Town
 - Central Service Center
 - Town Hall Addition
 - CR Water O&M Building
- Contracted price of \$714,930 plus 10% contingency for a total of \$786,430
- Budgeted for in Fire Capital

CHALLENGES

- Do not have all funding needed for construction
- Currently have \$6.3 million from TABOR timeout and impact fees
- Initial rough estimate for total project was approx. \$16.3 million
 - Will work with Owner's Rep and Architect to develop more accurate estimate
- Anticipate remainder of funding will come from future Certificates Of Participation (COPs)
