

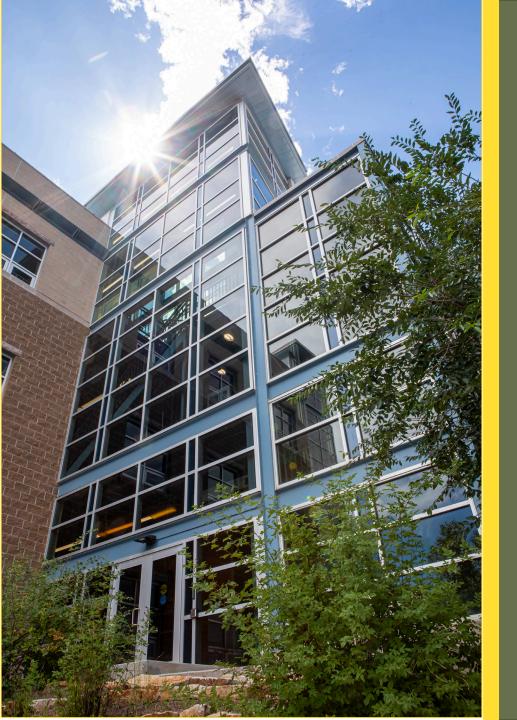
# **TOWN MANAGER'S OFFICE** January 2025

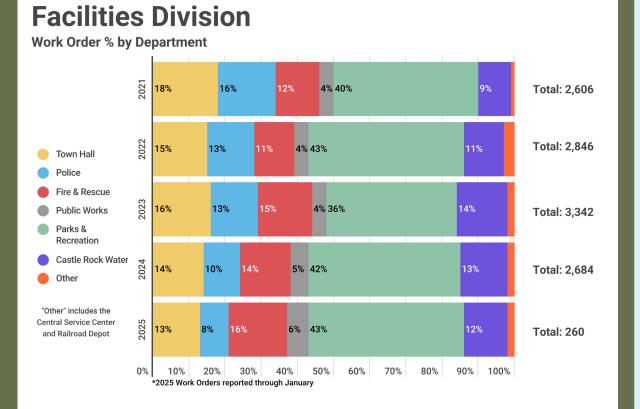


## **Facilities** Key Accomplishments

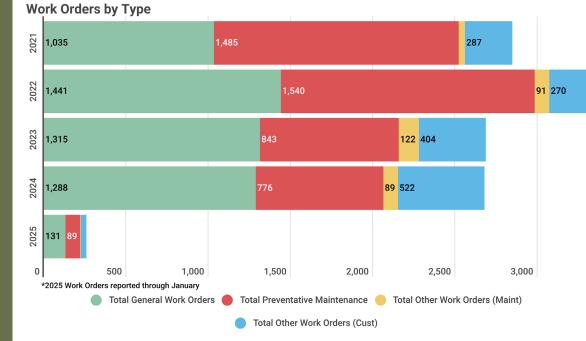


- In January, the Facilities team completed 260 work orders including 89 preventative maintenance activities and 29 custodial inspections. There was one emergency work order in January
- Completed emergency repairs on generators at Fire Stations #152 and #153
- Handled snow removal during two snow events in January
- Completed warranty repairs on floors/counters in Rec Center locker rooms
- Posted to fill vacant Lead Sr. Maintenance Technician position
- Supported planning and design efforts for the Fire Station #156 project and the electrical service upgrade project at the Cantril building

## **DoIT** Key Accomplishments



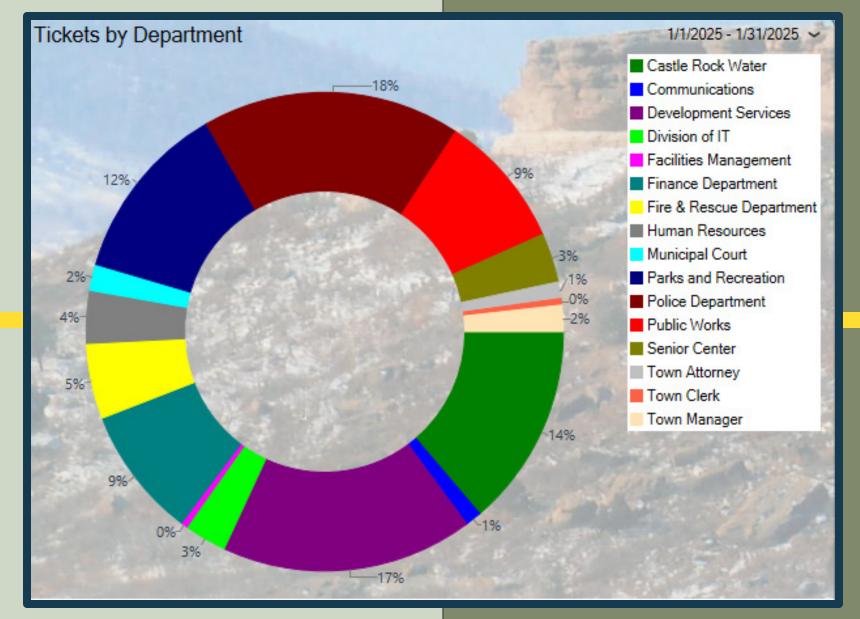
- Implemented map updates for Town annexations
- Patched critical vulnerabilities on Castle Rock
  Police Department servers
- Replaced end-of-life cameras at Castle Rock Recreation Center
- Installed fiber network connectivity to the Meadows Water Treatment Plant
- Continued progress on HB21-1110 accessibility requirements

- Addressed 424 total tickets, with an average time to resolve of 44 hours
- There were four emergency tickets this month, 100% of which were resolved within one calendar day (80% is the goal)
- There were 22 urgent priority tickets this month, 100% of which were resolved within two calendar days (85% is the goal)
- There were 343 medium priority tickets this month, 99.7% of which were resolved within 10 calendar days (90% is the goal)

- Addressed 27 total tickets, with an average time to resolve of 79 hours
- There were six annexations in January, 100% of which were reflected within the GIS database map within one week of receipt; the goal is to have 90% of annexations reflected within that timeframe
- There were six zoning change in January, 100% of which were reflected within the GIS database map within two weeks of receipt; the goal is to have 90% of zoning changes reflected within that timeframe
- There were no parcel updates in January

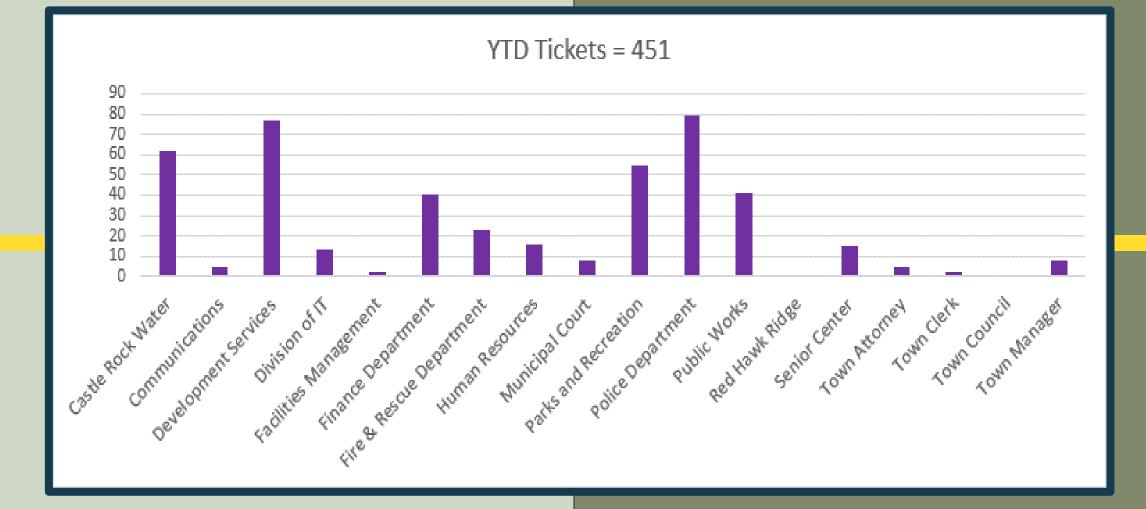

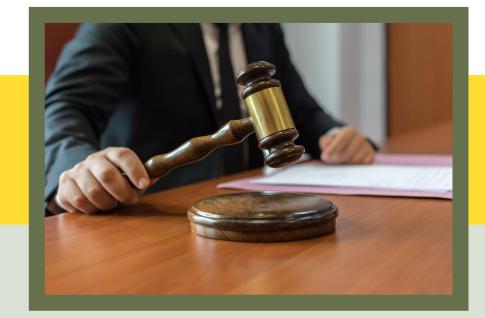

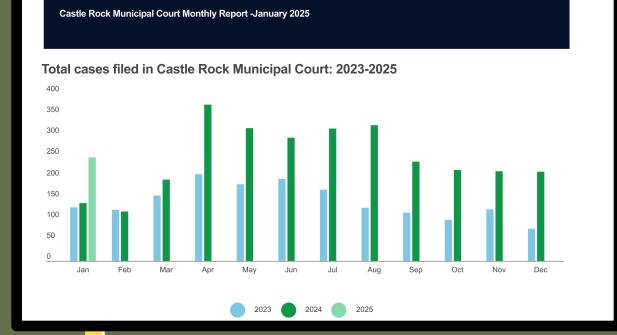
### Municipal Court Key Accomplishments

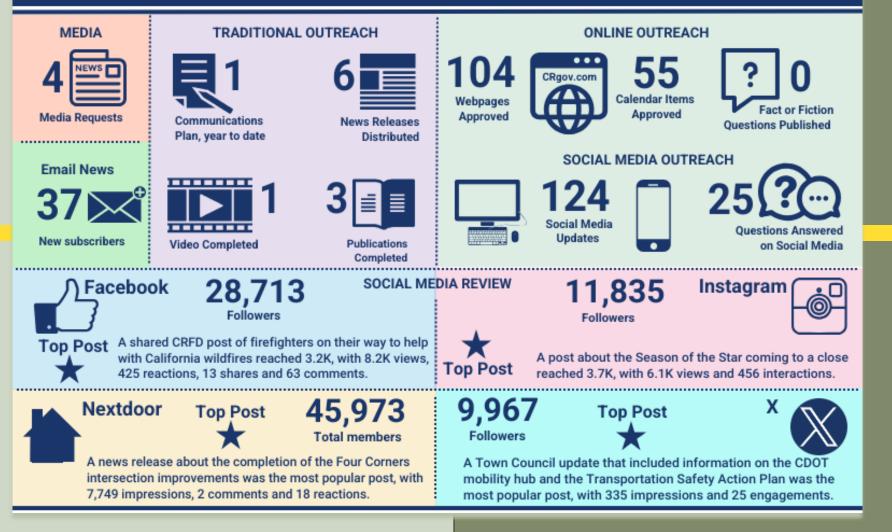
