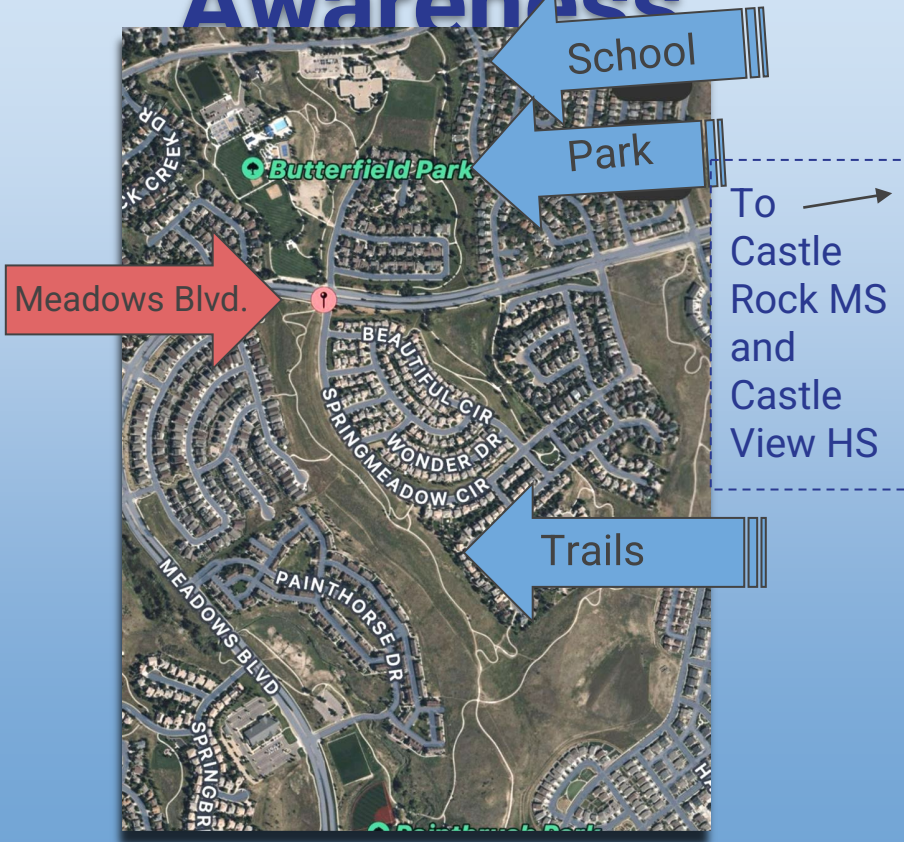

ADA Route at Butterfield Crossing Park

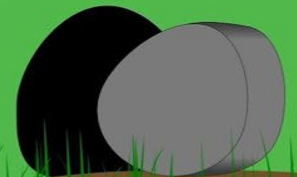
Why This Crossing?

- High Traffic Volume, Vehicle and Pedestrian
