## **HISTORY**

- Built in 1897
- Two-story, Italian Villa style building with a threestory bell tower
- Operated as a school until 1984, then used for DCSD offices
- Nationally landmarked in 1984
- Castle Rock Historic Preservation ordinance approved 1994, with first properties landmarked that year
