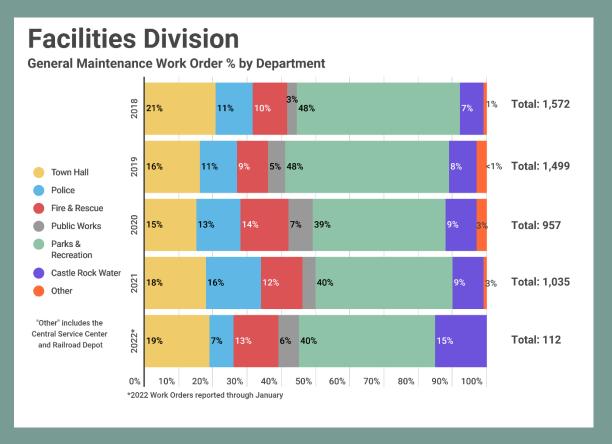

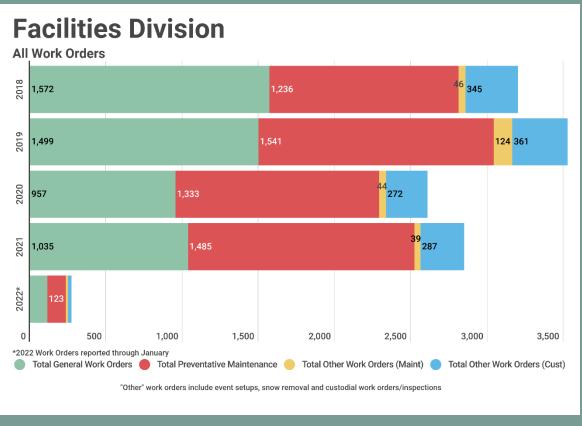
Serves as an internal consulting resource, provides innovative programs in support of the Town's values and fosters positive work relationships



- Completed 123 preventative maintenance activities and 22 custodial inspections, in addition to regular work order requests. In total, the Facilities Team handled 270 work orders in January up 21% over January 2021
- Removed scaffolding in Development Services related to December window repairs
- Completed fire line backflow repairs
- Completed Town Hall and Police Department snow removal for **five** events in January
- Completed planning and contract preparation for chemical door replacement at the Recreation Center
- Planning and support for numerous other projects including the Police Department basement renovation, Police Department ADA improvements and Town Hall office modifications

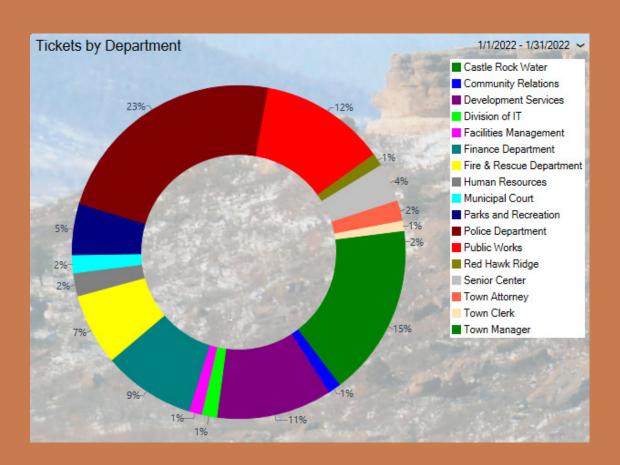


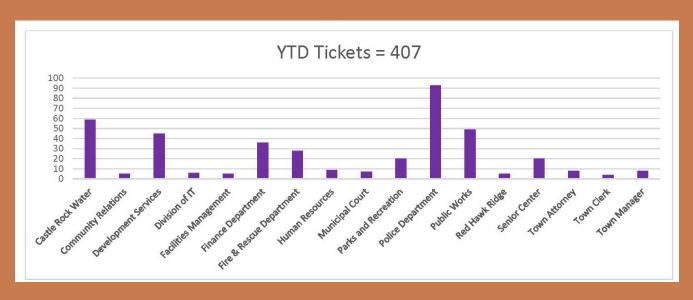

	There were no parcel updates in January (100%)						



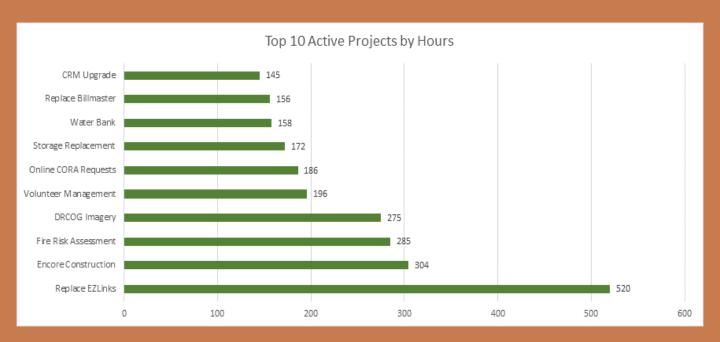

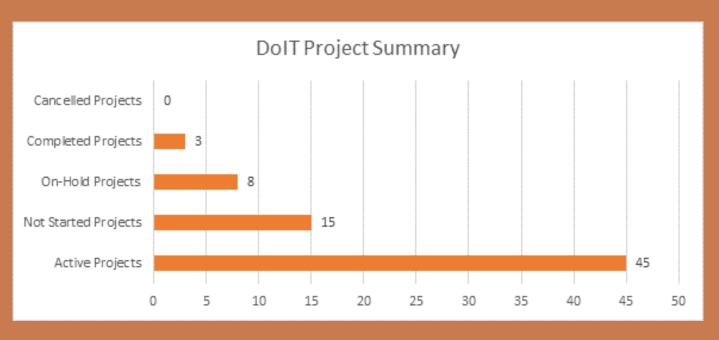

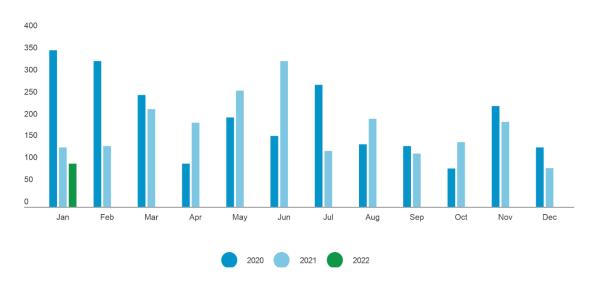
MC Key Accomplishments

- The Court implemented a new procedure for handling traffic cases. This procedure was created in response to new legislation, HB 21-1314, that eliminates Municipal Courts' ability to place a hold on a driver's license for non compliance with court conditions. This procedure includes a new plea form and a different method of reporting to DMV
- The Court posted a position for a Part-Time Arraignment Court Clerk and will begin the hiring process
- The court is auditing and working through cases in which fines/fees are outstanding. In total, for the month of January, we sent 51 cases to collections. The majority of these cases are related to the changes of HB21-1314



Castle Rock Municipal Court Monthly Report -January 2022

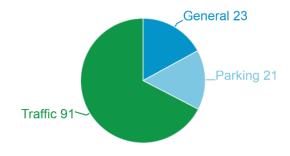
Total cases filed in Castle Rock Municipal Court: 2020-2022

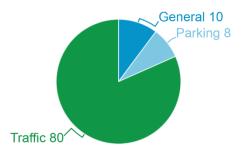
