WHEREAS, the CDBG Program has considerable flexibility to allow communities to carry out activities that are tailored to their unique housing and neighborhood revitalization needs; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Castle Rock believes this is an important program and has plans to become an entitlement city in the future.



WHEREAS, the CDBG Program has considerable flexibility to allow communities to carry out activities that are tailored to their unique housing and neighborhood revitalization needs; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Castle Rock believes this is an important program and has plans to become an entitlement city in the future.




