# BACKGROUND AND RECOMMENDATION

- The Castle Rock Urban Renewal Authority (CRURA) is a “local public body” within the meaning of the Colorado Open Meetings Law (COML).
- The CRURA Board is required to designate the public place for posting notices of public meetings at the first regular meeting of the calendar year.
- Per COML, CRURA will have given “full and timely notice” of a public meeting if it posts the notice no less than 24 hours prior to the meeting on CRURA’s public website (<https://castlerockrenewal.org/>.)
