

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-069

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DEWBERRY ENGINEERS INC. FOR THE YOUNG AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, Dewberry Engineers Inc. (the “Consultant”), previously completed the majority of the engineering analysis and design on the Young American Infrastructure Improvements Project (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado (the “Town”) has determined that the Project requires additional improvements to ensure that sidewalks affected by the Project are upgraded to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act requirements, and that minor outstanding waterline design items still exist; and

WHEREAS, Town staff has determined that Consultant is best suited to provide engineering design and analysis services for the Project due to its intimate knowledge of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has approved the use of the Consultant on the basis of sole source; and

WHEREAS, subject to Town Council’s approval, the Town and the Consultant have agreed to the terms and conditions by which Consultant will provide engineering design and analysis services to the Town for the Project (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, Town Staff recommends Town Council approve the Agreement with the Consultant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval. The Agreement between the Town and the Consultant is hereby approved in substantially the same form as presented at tonight’s meeting, with such technical changes, additions, modifications, deletions, or amendments as the Town Manager may approve upon consultation with the Town Attorney. The Mayor and other proper Town officials are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and any technical amendments thereto by and on behalf of the Town.

Section 2. Encumbrance and Authorization for Payment. In order to meet the Town’s financial obligations under this Agreement, the Town Council authorizes the expenditure and payment in an amount not to exceed \$94,490.00, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Town.
