Goals: Under the direction of Town Council, educate the community on the November 2018 election. Explain the eight Charter amendment questions that will be on the ballot and the impact those questions could have on Town government. Identify the three open seats – District 3, District 5 and Mayor. Inform the public on important dates including Election Day, the last day to register to vote, and the due date for circulated petitions.

Audiences: Castle Rock registered voters

Key Messages:

- The Town will have several local-government related questions on the November 2018 election ballot. This will include three seats District 3, District 5 and Mayor and seven Charter amendment questions.
- The Charter amendment questions relate to the restructuring of Town Council to six Council Districts and a
 Mayor elected at large, as well as signature requirements for the nomination of Mayor and members of Town
 Council. These questions will be among the final details to clean up language in Town Charter regarding Castle
 Rock's Mayor being elected at large.
- The Town Council seats up for election are District 3 (which includes eastern portions of The Meadows and Red Hawk), District 5 (which includes southeast Castle Rock) and the Mayor, who will be elected at large.
- Election day is Tuesday, Nov. 6. The Town of Castle Rock conducts all of its elections by mail. Ballots will be mailed the week of Oct. 15. Drop off locations will be in the parking lot of Town Hall and Douglas County Elections.
