Worked closely with AT&T's Federal Government Affairs office in DC on all regulatory policy issues including lobbying the Executive Branch, Legislative Branch and FCC on important regulatory changes including the reasons behind rate adjustments being proposed by AT&T Broadband. Managed a professional staff of approximately 30 individuals across the country. Worked closely with Comcast on the elimination of the corporate level regulatory group to a decentralized regulatory staff as a result of the acquisition of AT&T Broadband by Comcast.

Initiated TCP's corporate regulatory group in 1995 as Vice President, Rates with responsibility for all rate regulatory filings for the entire organization. In 1996 successfully completed TCI's first national rate settlement regarding CPST rates with the FCC resulting in significant cost saving to TCI and enhanced rate stability. Worked closely with the FCC and NCTA on all policy issues before the FCC related to rates especially the creation of the annual rate adjustment mechanism. Assisted the M&A department in assessing rate liabilities for acquired Was asked by the COO of TCI to co-manage the Franchising group as well as the regulatory function, concentrating on developing the relationships with the local Franchising authorities and the National Association of Telecommunications Officers and Advisors. Became the Senior Vice President of Franchising and Regulatory Affairs in 1998. Became a member of the NCTA Accounting subcommittee and one of the leading industry professionals on regulatory policy. Worked closely with TCI's Government Affairs organization on lobbying national and state governments on the rate adjustments proposed by TCI. Worked closely with the EVP of Government Affairs on the merger of TCI into AT&T including negotiating with Local Franchise Authorities on the terms and conditions for approval of the transfer to AT&T. In addition to responsibility of the rate regulatory activities, added senior management responsibility for the Copyright filings, FCC Technical filings, Must-Carry analyses and Sports Blackout activities culminating in a professional staff of 26 employees and a budget of approximately \$3 million.
