ORDINANCE NO. 2025-032

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2026 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Town Manager of the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado (the "Town") has submitted the proposed budget for the 2026 fiscal year (the "2026 Budget") to the Town Council, in compliance with Section 9-4 of the Town Charter (the "Charter"); and

WHEREAS, proper notice was published in accordance with Section 9-6 of the Charter for a public hearing on the 2026 Budget at the October 7, 2025, Town Council meeting; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the 2026 Budget has been published on the Town's website; and

WHEREAS, according to Section 9-6(c) of the Charter, the Town Council shall adopt the 2026 Budget by ordinance on or before the final day established by law for the certification of the ensuing year's tax levy to the county, which day is December 15, 2025; and

WHEREAS, upon review, Town Council is prepared to adopt the 2026 Budget in the form presented without amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO:

Section 1. Approval. The 2026 Budget is hereby approved and adopted in the form presented at tonight's meeting. The following amounts are hereby appropriated by fund for the 2026 fiscal year:

Section 2. Compliance. The 2026 Budget, as approved and adopted, complies with Article IX of the Charter, and the total authorized expenditures and provisions for contingencies do not exceed the total estimated revenues.

Section 3. Open Space Fund. There is hereby established an Open Space Fund into which shall be deposited fifty percent (50%) of all revenues collected by the Town from payment of the use tax levied on the privilege of storing, using or consuming in the Town any construction and building materials pursuant to Section 3.04.180.A of the Castle Rock Municipal Code. Such revenues may be expended for the acquisition, maintenance, or improvement of Town open space and any purposes related thereto.

Section 4. Economic Development Fund. There is hereby established an Economic Development Fund into which shall be deposited fifty percent (50%) of all revenues collected by the Town from payment of the use tax levied on the privilege of storing, using or consuming in the Town any construction and building materials pursuant to Section 3.04.180.A of the Castle Rock Municipal Code. Such revenues may be expended for purposes related to the economic development of the Town.

Section 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.
