Whereas, Rob Hanna has led the development of the Castle Rock's Parks & Recreation Department since 1998;

Whereas, for nearly two decades, Hanna led a team in the creation of some of Castle Rock's signature facilities, including 19 parks and the new 230-acre Philip S. Miller Park and 60,000-square-foot Miller Activity Complex.

Whereas, Hanna led the Town in developing additional Town amenities, including 50 miles of trails and more than 2,720 acres of open space;
