# **STATE OF COLORADO**

#### November 2022 – Citizen-initiated ballot measure

 Colorado voters approved the Natural Medicine Health Act, a citizeninitiated measure intended to decriminalize the use of certain plants or fungi for people 21 years of age and older

#### May 2023 – Senate Bill 23-290

- "Natural Medicine Regulation and Legalization" act clarifies and sets the regulatory framework for a regulated natural medicine program in Colorado
- Unlike retail and medical marijuana, the State Code does not give the option of "saying no" to "natural medicine" businesses. Local jurisdiction may regulate specific items.

# NATURAL MEDICINE REGULATION AND LEGALIZATION BILL

The State Code allows municipalities to enact ordinances which:

- (i) Regulate the time, place and manner of the operation of natural medicine business licenses issued by the State;
- (ii) Limit the areas where the cultivation, manufacturing, testing, storage, distribution, transfer and dispensation of natural medicine and natural medicine product may be permitted; and
- (iii) Establish the distance restrictions for buildings where natural medicine services are provided within the vicinity of a child care center, preschool, elementary, middle, junior or high school, residential child care facility, or residential dwelling.

Section 44-50-104(5)(a), C.R.S.

# NATURAL MEDICINE REGULATION AND LEGALIZATION BILL

*Natural medicine business* means any of the following entities licensed under the Regulatory Act and includes a natural medicine healing center, a natural medicine cultivation facility, a natural medicine products manufacturer, or a natural medicine testing facility, or another licensed entity created by the state licensing authority.

*Natural medicine healing center* means a facility where an entity is licensed by the state licensing authority that permits a facilitator as defined by the Regulatory Act, to provide and supervise natural medicine services for a participant as defined by the Regulatory Act, which includes a participant consuming and experiencing the effects of regulated natural medicine product under the supervision of a facilitator.

# RECOMMENDATION


Proposed Castle Rock ordinance would:

- Allow natural medicine businesses in Light Industrial (I-1) and General Industrial (I-2) zoned land, subject to the following restrictions:
  - A. 1,000 feet from **the property line** of a child care center; preschool; elementary, middle, junior or highschool; or a residential child care facility (schools)
  - B. 1,000 feet from **the property line** of single-family dwellings, duplexes, or multi-family dwellings (residential)
  - C. A & B do not apply to licensed facilities on land owned by the Town or State, or to licensed facilities that exist BEFORE a school or residence is built
- Restrict hours of operation between 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Additionally, the propose ordinance that would:


- Limit public view into businesses
- Require storage of materials within permanent building
- Require clearly illuminated facilities with downward facing security lighting
- Confine odors to the premises
- Require secure disposal of product remnants or by-product
- Prohibit processing of medicine with hazardous materials



# LAND ZONED I-1 AND I-2

Existing I-1 and I-2 land shown in purple.

Town code does not allow any new land to be zoned I-1 or I-2 after June 1, 2022.


