DID YOU KNOW...

- The US Surgeon General has declared loneliness an epidemic in 2023
- Social isolation can be caused by loss of mobility, no longer driving, death of a spouse or living alone to name a few causes
- Chronic loneliness and social isolation can increase the risk of developing dementia by approximately 50% in older adults
- The highest rates of social isolation are found among older adults 65+
- Lacking social connection is as dangerous as smoking up to 15 cigarettes a day

By 2030, the Colorado State Demography Office predicts the 65+
Population will rise to 1.27 million, a 77 percent increase from 2015.
The Douglas County Older Adult population is projected to increase
154% by 2050. Douglas County is the fastest growing of
all Counties in Colorado for Older Adults.


