Re: Castle Rock EDC Mid-Year Report to Investors August 2015

Significant Projects and Economic Activity

In 2015, Castle Rock EDC has seen the exciting results of many years of hard work come to fruition with the ground breaking of the North Meadows Interchange, The Promenade at Castle Rock, Comcast Fiber buildout (Press Release Attached), Phillip S. Miller Park, The MOVE Technology building in Downtown, Montana Vista, the major expansion of MyWedding.com (Press Release Attached), and the recognition of Castle Rock, as the 2015 Large Community of the Year by the Economic Development Council of Colorado (Press Release Attached).

Castle Rock continues to see a very consistent unemployment rate (3.7%) below state (4.5%) and national (5.3%) levels. Key factors include high education attainment and the overall performance of the Metro Denver economy in key areas where Castle Rock residents have concentrated employment in technology, professional services, marketing, sales and management sectors. While low unemployment rates are positive it has put significant pressure on employers trying to recruit talent to Castle Rock due to increased upward wage pressure.

The EDC 2015 Prospect activity remains solid over the first half of the year with significant increases in Downtown redevelopment project activity. Colorado and Metro Denver continue to outpace the nation in job growth and was recently ranked by Forbes Magazine as the #1 place to do Business in the US. Regional growth continues to outpace all of the 2015 regional forecasts in both job creation and capital investment.

Retail

The Outlets at Castle Rock, The Promenade at Castle Rock Lifestyle Center and The Meadows
Development continue to lead the charge in Castle Rock's strong retail market along with growing retail
investment in Downtown Castle Rock throughout the first half of 2015. Castle Rock's aggressive single
family home starts (averaging 100 per month) and high median family income (\$102,961 (County
Average)) continue to attract strong retail development opportunities. The Outlets have secured a
regional expansion of Restoration Hardware and have added Starbucks and Qdoba to their
development. The Promenade Lifestyle Center development continues to sign more new and exciting
tenants each month and The Meadows Town Center project has plans for additional retail development.
These developments are all critical in providing for essential goods and services to the west side of I-25
and reducing traffic pressure on Founders Boulevard as well as creating a strong tax base for essential
Town services in accommodating the healthy growth of the community.

Business Infrastructure

Development infrastructure has been a highlight of 2015 with significant private sector investment made by Comcast Business to support the proactive buildout and retro-fitting of high speed fiber and coaxial connectivity in the Wolfersberger, Park Street and Citadel business districts. This investment is essential to future business attraction success and in helping our existing business compete. Public Investments in the North Meadows Parkway, Renewable Water System buildout and the Phillip S. Miller Park are laying the ground work for future private sector development and additional economic opportunity.

Business Retention/Expansion

Existing businesses in Castle Rock have been thriving and expanding. In a recent 2015 Douglas County primary employer survey, 64% of Castle Rock businesses reported that they intend to expand their operations within the next 3 years and 58% intend to add additional employees over the next 12 months. While the number of new projects like Montana Vista, "The Move", Caprice Commerce Center and The ConneXion Spot have/will add additional office and industrial space to the market a significant portion has already been absorbed prior to vertical construction which has left Castle Rock's office and commercial vacancy rates largely unchanged in the last six months; hovering around 6% and 1% respectively. The lack of contiguous available space continues to put additional pressure on retaining existing growing employers and attracting new employers to the market. This is consistent with the data collected through primary employer survey which identified the availability high speed internet (fiber), the cost of health care and the cost/availability of commercial real estate as the top three challenges to doing business in Castle Rock. There is a genuine concern by Castle Rock EDC that the projected primary job growth from our existing employers may force some companies to leave Castle Rock in search of additional space. In general, growing companies have very compact time horizons for satisfying the need for additional space. As it stands, Castle Rock has extreme difficulty in accommodating that growth.

Challenges and Opportunities

Finding creative and innovative solutions to the lack of available contiguous industrial and office space continues to be Castle Rock EDC's top priority, as it is the most serious constraint Castle Rock has to attracting and retaining primary employers that create jobs for Castle Rock citizens. There are no fast, easy or inexpensive solutions to this issue, however the developer prospect activity remains strong despite challenges that are both complex and formidable. Public/Private partnerships will continue to be essential to the success of Castle Rock in order to build a strong physical and digital infrastructure base to accommodate future growth.






UNEMPLOYMENT COMPARISON



Expansion of Comcast's Fiber Network Provides High-Speed Connectivity for Colorado Businesses

DENVER – **June 9, 2015** – <u>Comcast Business</u> today announced that its full portfolio of Ethernet services is now available to businesses in Castle Rock, CO.
