



FM Key Accomplishments

- Completed 2023 Computer Replacement Project - 234 computers!



Help Desk	Addressed 426 total tickets, with an average time to resolve of 44 hours There were four emergency tickets this month, 100% of which were resolved within one calendar day (80% is the goal) There were 18 urgent priority tickets this month, 100% of which were resolved within two calendar days (85% is goal) There were 370 medium priority tickets this month, 99% of which were resolved within 10 calendar days (90% is goal)
Geographic Information Systems (GIS)	Addressed 18 total tickets, with an average open-to- resolve time of 77 hours There were no annexations in September There were no zoning changes in September There was one parcel update in September (100%), which was reflected within the GIS database map within four weeks of receipt; the goal is to have 90% of parcel changes reflected within that timeframe







MC Key Accomplishments


- Teen Court Teen Court held **three** peer panels in September
