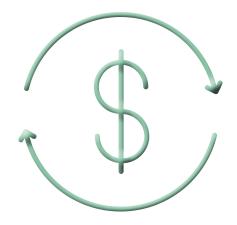
Accounting

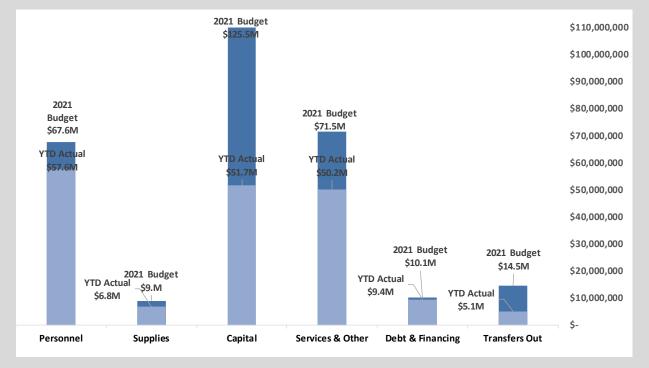

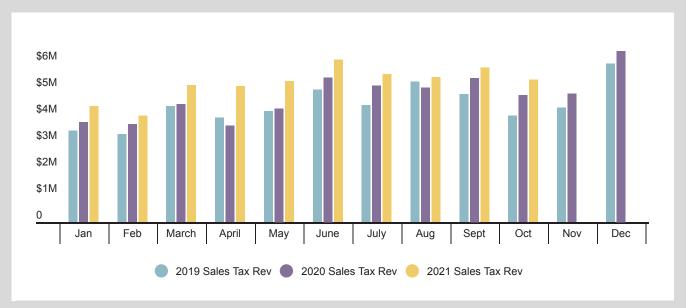








REVENUE



As sales tax returns are due 20 days after the end of the month, this report shows the prior month's revenue.

Communicating results

Sales tax collections for October were up 12.2 percent from the previous year's month, or up \$585,220 compared to October 2020. Year-to-date (YTD) collections are up 14.7 percent compared to the same time frame in 2020. Staff will continue to monitor this very important revenue stream for the Town and inform
