

**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-137**

**A RESOLUTION NAMING THE NEW NEIGHBORHOOD PARK IN THE  
PLUM CREEK NORTH NEIGHBORHOOD EMERALD PARK**

**WHEREAS**, recently, the Town of Castle Rock (the “Town”) started construction of a new neighborhood park adjacent to Emerald Drive in the Plum Creek North neighborhood, with construction scheduled to be completed in the Summer of 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, in anticipation of next year’s opening, the Town conducted community outreach to gather feedback on the name for the park; and

**WHEREAS**, the community submitted nearly 500 open-ended suggestions and expressed 230 naming preferences, in which Emerald Park emerged as a top choice; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town’s facility-naming policy provides that the goal for selecting names shall be fostering a sense of community, including names that heighten awareness of Town history, celebrate the natural environment and call attention to people, events and geography that have shaped the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town staff naming committee and the Parks and Recreation Commission have recommended that the park currently being constructed in Plum Creek North be named Emerald Park.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.     Naming of Park.** The new neighborhood park in the Plum Creek North neighborhood is hereby named Emerald Park.

**Section 2.     Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
