Other Activity

Public Records Request Software - GovQA was selected as the software to automate, streamline, and improve the public interface for CORA requests. Staff will fine tune the product and provide training to affected staff, then will begin utilizing this new product.

Liquor Licensing Software - Evaluating software to assist with automation, streamlining processes, and improved public interface for processing liquor licensing, automating reminders to licensees, and providing a portal for them to access their information, submit applications, pay fees, and check their status, etc.

Electronics Recycling Event - Hosted by the Town Clerk's Office and the Division of Innovation and Technology. We are partnering with DoIT to allow Town employees, including Town Council, to bring their electronic devices to be recycled. All computers, smart phones, etc., will have their data erased to protect your PII informaton.

This year, we have arranged to allow you to bring in your televisions and computer monitors for a fee payable in Cash or Check to the recycling company. It is difficult to find someone who will accept these items; so we arranged for the company we are contracting with to accept them.

The event is on August 12 from 11am-1pm. Town employees and Town Council will receive a flyer.

Updates & New Legislation:

Festival Permit: Legislation passed to allow Beer Fests, Distillery Fests, that previously only allowed wineries to hold WineFests. They are now all categorized under a Festival Permit. In addition, any on-premise license (Restaurant, Bar, Beer & Wine, etc.) may also participate and sell their liquor at these Festivals. *Effective September 7*.

State Liquor Fees Waived: State waiving New License & Renewal fees for On Premise licenses until October, 2021.

To Go Liquor: Can continue to be sold until July 2026 - Must obtain a permit from the State.

Liquor Store Deliveries: Must obtain a permit from the State.

Ranked Choice Voting: Counties will be required to obtain certified voting equipment that will perform Ranked Choice Voting and will be required to coordinate with Municipalities in November elections to conduct Ranked Choice Voting if they request it by 2023.
