Budget

- The first reading of the 4th Quarter Budget Amendment was presented to Town Council on October 7th and the second reading occurred on October 20th
- Financial Analysts continued preparation of the proposed 2016 Budget, 5 Year CIP, and 2016-2018 Three Year Balanced Financial Plan drafts presented to Town Council on October 20^{th.} The first reading is scheduled for November 3rd with a second reading planned to occur on December 1st

- Staff incorporated changes to the funding structure proposed for Festival Park presented to Town Council on October 20th with a follow up scheduled to occur at the November 17th Council meeting

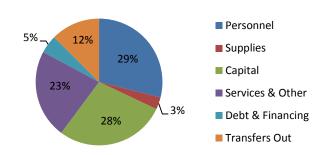


Grants

Parks and Recreation presented to Town Council on November 3rd to request support of a Local Parks and Outdoor Recreation Grant Application to the State Board of the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund (GOCO) for the Festival Park project. The grant request is for \$350,000 to be used toward this project. The grant application is due on November 5th, 2015 and award notifications are expected to occur in March 2016.

The Department of Justice notified the Police Department that they will receive over \$7k toward bullet proof vests. Since the Bulletproof Vests Program began, the Town has been awarded over \$51k (includes award above) toward the purchase of bulletproof vests. Vests are replaced every 5 years based on manufacturers recommended replacement schedule

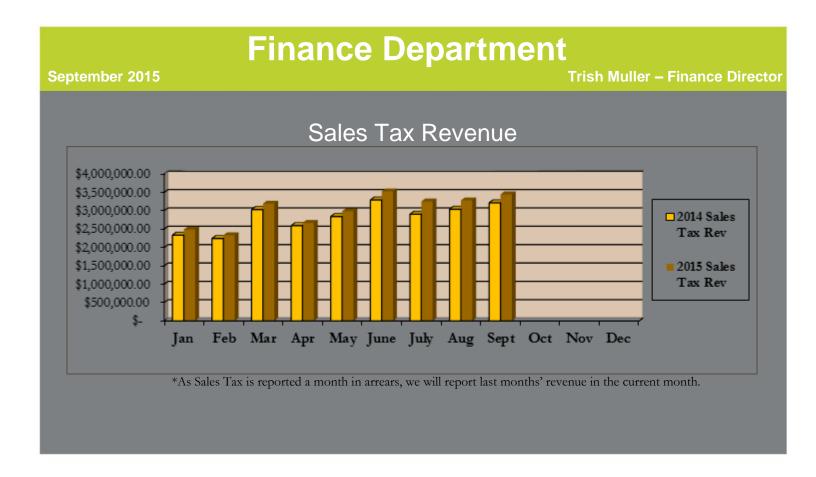
Jane Chrestensen is the Sales Tax Technician for the Town of Castle Rock Finance Department.
