#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-033**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 3.16, 4.04, 13.12, 13.15, AND 13.30 OF THE CASTLE ROCK MUNICIPAL CODE BY CHANGING STORMWATER DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES, RENEWABLE WATER RESOURCE FEES, WATER AND WASTEWATER SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT FEES, AND WATER, WATER RESOURCES, WASTEWATER AND STORMWATER RATES AND SURCHARGES

**WHEREAS**, in 2010, the Town Council of the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado (the "Town") directed Town staff to prepare and present annual updates to Castle Rock Water rates and fees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has considered and accepted Castle Rock Water's analyses and recommendations and the following reports prepared by Stantec Consulting Services, Inc.: (i) the 2025 Castle Rock Water Rates and Fees Study Update – Vol. 1 of 2: 2026–2030 Rates, Final Report dated September 15, 2025; and (ii) 2025 Castle Rock Water Rates and Fees Study – Vol. 2 of 2: System Development Fees, Final Report dated September 15, 2025; and

WHEREAS, increases in the actual rate of growth for the last five years over projected growth rates, changes to estimates on long-term buildout of the Town, disruptions to the renewable water rights market based on increased water scarcity, increases in inflation and construction costs for water infrastructure, requirements to issue debt to smooth future water rate increases, updates to long-term capital plans to support growth, and increases in the costs for water rights and meters all substantiate the proposed changes to Stormwater Development Impact Fees, Renewable Water Resource Fees, Water and Wastewater System Development Fees, and Water, Water Resources, and Stormwater Rates and Surcharges; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Town and its residents to approve the proposed changes to Castle Rock Water rates and fees.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO:

- **Section 1.** <u>Legislative Findings</u>. The recitals to this Ordinance are adopted as findings of the Town Council in support of enactment of this Ordinance, and, in addition, the Town Council finds that:
- A. The fee structure established by this Ordinance is supported by:
  - 1. 2025 Castle Rock Water Rates and Fees Study Update Vol. 1 of 2: 2026-2030 Rates, Final Report dated September 2025;
  - 2. 2025 Castle Rock Water Rates and Fees Study Vol. 2 of 2: System Development Fees, Final Report dated September 2025;

- 3. The Staff Report dated September 15, 2025, prepared by the Director of Castle Rock Water, and the accompanying PowerPoint presentation offered at first and second reading of this Ordinance; and
- 4. Public comment and testimony.
- B. The fees and charges imposed by this Ordinance comply with the legislative restrictions on impact fees adopted by local governments in § 29-20-104.5, C.R.S.
- **Section 2.** <u>Amendment.</u> The Residential and Non-Residential Stormwater Development Impact Fee tables in Subsections A and B of Section 3.16.030 of the Castle Rock Municipal Code are amended to read as follows:
- 3.16.030 Assessment and collection.

Commencing January 1, 2023, i-Impact fees shall be assessed and collected according to the following provisions, including Section 3.16.035:

A. *Residential uses*. No building permit shall be issued for any dwelling unit prior to the payment of the following applicable fees:

**Section 3.** <u>Amendment</u>. Section 4.04.150.A of the Castle Rock Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

4.04.150 - Renewable water resource fee.

A. In order to defray the cost incurred by the Town in the acquisition and development of renewable water resources consistent with the water plan and this Chapter, there is imposed a renewable water resource fee as a condition to the right to connect to the municipal water system. The renewable water resource fee is established at the following schedule of fees in effect as of the date of a complete building permit application:

**Section 13.** <u>Safety Clause.</u> The Town Council finds and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated and adopted for the public health, safety and welfare and this Ordinance bears a rational relation to the legislative object sought to be obtained.

**Section 14. Effective Date**. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2026.
