

Douglas County Immigration Enforcement Lawsuit Resolution of Support



Immigration Enforcement Lawsuit

- Challenges two bills adopted by the Colorado General Assembly.
- House Bill 19-1124 prohibits law enforcement officers from cooperating with federal immigration enforcement authorities on civil federal immigration detention requests.
- House Bill 23-1100 prohibits state and local governments from contracting with the federal government for purposes related to immigration detention facilities.

Timeline

- April 15, 2024 – Douglas and El Paso Counties announce the filing of the Immigration Enforcement Lawsuit.
- April 16, 2024 – Town Council directs the Town Attorney's Office to explore the potential legal ramifications associated with joining the Immigration Enforcement Lawsuit.
- May 7, 2024 – Town Attorney and Town Manager recommend that the Town Council adopt a resolution of support for the Immigration Enforcement Lawsuit.
