

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-032**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2026 TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK  
WATER CONSERVATION REBATE INCENTIVE PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado (the “Town”), acting by and through the Castle Rock Water Enterprise (“Castle Rock Water”), offers a Water Conservation Rebate Incentive Program (the “Program”) to its water customers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Program is designed to assist customers with their behaviors, designs, and technologies that will help them save water through the promotion of the use of water conservation best management practices; and

**WHEREAS**, the Program increases public awareness of the continued need for wise water use; and

**WHEREAS**, Castle Rock Water staff recommends that the Town continue using revenues from the watering restriction violations and a portion of Block 4 surcharge rate to fund the Program; and

**WHEREAS**, Castle Rock Water staff further recommends that, with the ongoing conversion of the Town to an advanced metering infrastructure (AMI) system, the Whole Home Water Monitoring System rebate be discontinued in its entirety; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Approval.** The 2026 Town of Castle Rock Water Conservation Rebate Incentive Program is hereby adopted in substantially the same form as presented at tonight’s meeting.
