Neighborhood Meeting Summary – Avilla at Founders Village (Bella Mesa South) Second Neighborhood Meeting – January 20, 2022

NexMetro Communities and Norris Design held a neighborhood meeting to discuss a proposed Site Development Plan project known as Avilla at Founders Vista (Bella Mesa South). Avilla at Founders Vista (Bella Mesa) is approximately 9 acres in size and located at the northwest corner of Mikelson Blvd. and Mitchell St. (see attached vicinity map). The Site Development Plan calls for a mixture of for rent single family detached homes and paired homes for a total unit count of 105 units.
