ACCOUNTING ACTIVITIES

On June 20th, the 2016 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report was presented to Town Council. Accounting submits a copy of the audited CAFR to:

- State of Colorado per state statute requirements.
- Electronic Municipal Market Access (EMMA), a service of Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (MSRB) per continued disclosure requirements.
- Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) for submission for the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting Award.

The Certificate of Achievement is a prestigious national award that is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting. In order to be awarded a Certificate of Achievement, a government must publish an easily readable and efficiently organized comprehensive annual financial report. This report must satisfy both generally accepted accounting principles and applicable legal requirements.

The Town has received this award for twenty six consecutive years.






ACCOUNTS PAYABLE / PURCHASING


FINANCIAL ANALYST ACTIVITIES

BUDGET DEVELOPMENTS


- Second Amendment to the 2017 Budget was presented for first reading to Council on June 6th and second reading on June 20th

ACTUAL EXPENDITURES BY CATEGORY





This graph illustrates how many business licenses are issued per month, by area.


