

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-049

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK
SNOWPLOWING AND ICE CONTROL POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado (the “Town”), adopted the Snowplowing and Ice Control Policy (the “Policy”) on November 18, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Town has updated the Policy to allow the Town Manager to conduct plowing activities on residential streets regardless of snow accumulation totals; and

WHEREAS, the amendments to the Policy will allow for a proactive response to weather conditions that may result in persistent snow pack and icing within travel lanes of residential streets; and

WHEREAS, Town Staff recommends that Town Council approve the amendments to the Policy; and

WHEREAS, Town Council finds that the amendments to the Policy will help to improve the Town’s response to weather conditions and are required for the health, safety and welfare of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption. The amended Snowplowing and Ice Control Policy, attached as *Exhibit 1* is hereby approved and adopted.
