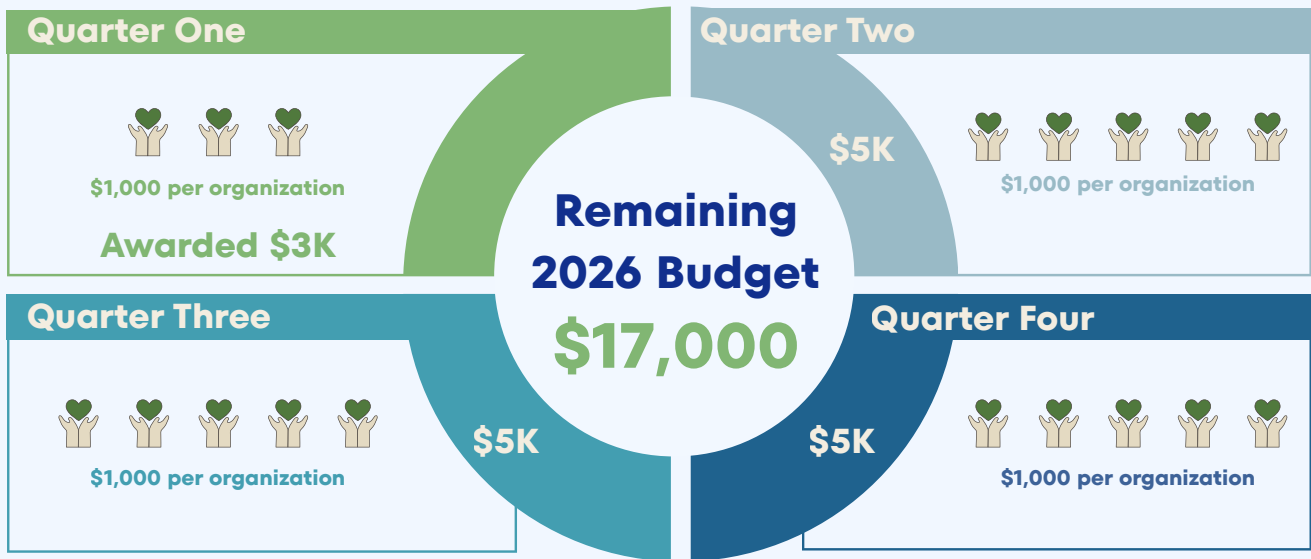


# COUNCIL COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM

On December 2, 2025, Council voted to amend the Council Community Grant Program annual budget to \$20,000, with \$5,000 allocated per quarter and \$1,000 cap per applicant.

Colorado TINTS (Theater in non traditional spaces)	The Wind Is Us: The Death That Killed Capote is an award-winning solo performance starring Denver actor Eddie Schumacher, winner of Best Actor at NYC's United Solo Festival. Touring audiences across Colorado, New York, and the United Kingdom, the production brings nationally recognized artistic excellence to Douglas County.	<b>Ineligible</b> Ineligible as performing and visual arts are no longer within project areas; referred to the Art & Culture Grant Program.
Agewise Colorado	Agewise Colorado is a free, statewide nonprofit that connects older adults, caregivers, and families with trusted information, educational programs, and more than 1,400 vetted service providers. Serving tens of thousands of Coloradans annually, the organization helps residents navigate aging-related resources and support services at no cost.	<b>Eligible</b> However, they are located in Denver.
A Precious Child	A Precious Child is a Colorado nonprofit that provides children and families facing poverty or crisis with essential resources, educational support, and opportunities that help them thrive. Through programs that provide basic needs, school supplies, extracurricular access, and workforce readiness services, the organization serves thousands of children across the Denver metro region each year.	<b>Eligible</b> However, they are located in Broomfield.
Castle Country Assisted Living	Castle Country Assisted Living is a Castle Rock nonprofit that provides compassionate, home-like assisted living for older adults with varying health and financial needs. Through three residential homes, the organization promotes dignity, safety, independence, and meaningful social connections while helping seniors maintain a high quality of life.	<b>Eligible</b> They have met all requirements
Castle Rock Police Department K9 Association	The Castle Rock Police Department K9 Association supports and promotes the innovative Police Therapy Dog Program, the first of its kind in Colorado. Through community education, training, and public art initiatives such as the "Sit, Stay, Heal" sculpture, the organization highlights the role therapy dogs play in supporting mental health, school safety, victim advocacy, and community trust.	<b>Ineligible</b> Ineligible as performing and visual arts are no longer within project areas; referred to the Art & Culture Grant Program.
