


- The Visitor Center: Warmly welcoming visitors, guests, residents and potential business and community investors to the Town. Business referrals and local resources provided upon entry.
- Website drives over 8,000 visits per month, average length of exploration is 3-5 minutes, exceeding industry standards.
 Exploring Chatbot options for increased service levels and 24/7 access.
- Average 40 guests walk-in and 60 phone calls weekly for resources and referrals. Maps, visitor guides, personal
 attention, and event information provided upon request.
- Partner with the DDA/DMA, EDC, and other Town partners to promote community events, activities, and attractions.
- Visit Castle Rock has a resourceful Community Calendar available to nonprofits and all organizations (members and non Chamber members) to post community events and activities, free of charge.
- Shop the Rock supports local business, sales tax revenues, and builds connectivity for all new residents to the community. Mailing distribution to more than 300 new residents and households monthly.
