## **ORDINANCE NO. 2023-008**

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE 2023 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET BY MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2023 FISCAL YEAR

**WHEREAS,** on September 20, 2022, the Town Council approved Ordinance No. 2022-021 adopting the annual budget and approving the amounts specified therein as expenditures for fiscal year 2023 (the "Fiscal Year 2023 Budget"); and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 9-10 of the Town Charter provides that, if during the fiscal year, the Town Manager certifies that there are available for appropriation revenues in excess of those estimated in the budget, the Town Council may by ordinance make supplemental appropriations for the year up to the amount of such excess; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Manager has certified that revenues collected in prior years are available to accommodate the additional authorized expenditures as set forth in the proposed First Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023 Budget; and

## NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO:

**Section 1.** <u>Budget Amendment.</u> The Fiscal Year 2023 Budget is amended to reflect the budgeting and appropriation of aggregate 2023 revenues and expenditures to the respective Town funds as follows:

**Section 4.** <u>Safety Clause.</u> The Town Council finds and declares that this Ordinance is adopted for the public health, safety and welfare and bears a rational relation to the legislative object sought to be obtained.
