

The Audit Committee will be meeting on June 9, 2017 and the CAFR will be presented to Town Council on June 20, 2017.



Accounts Payable is working with IREA and Black Hills Energy to coordinate the billing cycle to be consistent Town-wide.


Grant reimbursements were submitted for the High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) Grant and the Law Enforcement Assistance Fund (LEAF) Grant.



### LICENSING


- We have issued a total of 94 new business licenses in May, including in Town businesses.


- Revenue Division has collected \$38,467 from delinquent accounts for the month of April
