



DISCUSSION

- Town staff routinely reviews criteria manuals
- Each Town department is working on updates
- Vetted internally
- Checked against State/Federal standards
- Compared to other CO municipalities and industry standards

DOWNTOWN CRITERIA



PROPOSED CRITERIA TO BE UPDATED:

- Sidewalk widths, street lights, and pedestrian lights
- Criteria do not apply to tenant finishes, façade revisions, or constrained areas

RAPID FLASHING BEACONS



PROPOSED CRITERIA TO BE UPDATED:

New criteria section 8.5 with RRFB design criteria

UTILITY ENGINEERING

PROPOSED CRITERIA TO BE UPDATED:

- Required by New Colorado Law for work requiring excavation
- Updates to Section 13 of TDCM
 - TDCM edit specifies design plan submittal requirements

SMALL CELL FACILITIES



PROPOSED CRITERIA TO BE UPDATED:

- Section 16 is dedicated to small cell criteria
- Criteria provide standards for placement in Town right-ofway

OTHER MINOR CHANGES

PROPOSED CRITERIA TO BE UPDATED:

- Sidewalks / curb ramps
- Single family homes can front collectors
- Drainage features (i.e. inlets)
- Sight distance and vertical / horizontal curves
- Traffic signal / sign / marking changes
- Traffic Impact Analysis criteria
- Bike facility design
- Updated variance approval process

TOWN CODE CHANGES

- ✤ CRMC 15.42.010
 - Modification adopts 2023 TDCM
- ✤ CRMC 16.02.080
 - Modification clarifies vehicular access in alleys

 - Modification removes minimum sidewalk width
 - References TDCM for sidewalk design criteria
