



Human Resources Serves as an internal consulting resource, provides innovative programs in support of the Town's values and fosters positive work relationships

FM Key Accomplishments

- Completed 119 preventative maintenance activities and 16 custodial inspections in addition to regular work order requests. In total, the Facilities team handled 219 work orders in November
- Through November, the Facilities team completed 21% more work orders than the same period in 2021
- Completed **fire** inspections and elevator witness tests
- Ongoing implementation of new Work order Management Software completion expected in January
- Started contract renewal process for Facilities support vendors (roofing, HVAC, etc.)
- Installed walk-off carpet at the MAC
- Continued work on Fire Apparatus Bay Door Raise, PD Interior Renovation, PD parking improvements and Town Hall Renovation projects

- New Sales Tax Software update was successfully installed
- New Fire Records Management Software was implemented
- Completed a Motor Vehicle Collision density analysis and maps for Fire
- The Traffic Counts mapping site was updated with 2022 data



Geographic Information Systems (GIS)	open-to-resolve time of 53 hours There were no annexations, parcel or zoning updates in November




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
