## **ORDINANCE NO. 2016-004**

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE 2016 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING CHANGES IN APPROPRIATIONS FOR YEAR 2016

**WHEREAS** by Ordinance No. 2015-48 revenues and expenditures for the year 2016 were budgeted and appropriated,

**WHEREAS**, supplemental appropriation of revenues is authorized under Article IX of the Castle Rock Home Rule Charter, upon certification of the Town Manager of the availability of such revenues,

**WHEREAS**, since adoption of the 2016 Budget, receipt of additional revenues have been recognized and expenditures authorized therefrom.
