COMPREHENSIVE UPDATE

- Update of the Denver Regional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan
- Follows Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) planning process
- Satisfies the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000
- Identifies local hazards and vulnerabilities with defined mitigation actions
- Cooperative regional team
 - 5 of the 7 have adopted the plan

TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK SPECIFIC ACTIONS

THE TOWN HAS 3 OF 32 ACTION ITEMS

1. Stream Stabilization and Flood Control on Major Drainageways:
 - Improvements to reduce channel erosion and protect adjacent property from loss during flooding (2020)
2. Plum Creek/North Meadows Extension Flood Erosion Protection-Storm Drainage System:
 - 100-year flood plan contained in culverts at State Hwy 85 to eliminate roadway overtopping and protections of the new bridge girders from storm water erosion (2016)
3. Crystal Valley Storm water Collection Re-Design:
 - Eliminate erosion and excessive sediment to the Crystal Valley retention pond and fire station site (2016)
