Description of Organization: The Castle Rock Band is an all-volunteer group of musicians who rehearse two or three times per month and provide free concerts to the Castle Rock community throughout the year. These include our Summer Concert Series, a series of afternoon or evening concerts at the Bandstand in front of Miller Library on Wilcox Street. We perform an annual Memorial Day Weekend Concert with the local American Legion Post doing the presentation of colors to open the Concert. In May of this year, over 120 people attended the Memorial Weekend Concert. In prior years we have also participated in the Castle Rock Ducky Derby, Downtown Movie Night, and each year participate in Starlighting.

The Band welcomes musicians of all ages and all experience levels. We do not require auditions to join. Our members range from high school band members and home schooled students to senior citizens well into their 70s and beyond. The interaction between the generations is always positive as we work together on music for our concerts.

We invite new members to join us through stories in the local News Press, on our website, and at each of our concerts.

The Castle Rock Band was started by Kent Brandebery in 1999 and was patterned after the original Castle Rock Town Band that was in existence in the early 1900s. Along with more modern music, we continue each year to play some music from that time period in Castle Rock's history.

Description of specific project for which funds are requested: Our specific need at this time is for funds to pay for new music, and for rehearsal space. Because most of our concerts are in conjunction with a community event or at the Bandstand, we have been fortunate to obtain concert venues at no charge. We maximize our music funds by borrowing music at a low cost from the Chatfield Band Library so that we can use the music and then return it. However, we sometimes need music for a specific event that is not available to borrow.

Eligible project area for which funds are requested: Community-based performing visual arts programs and activities

How does this project benefit Castle Rock residents?: The Castle Rock Band provides an opportunity for musicians of all ages to perform together. In several cases this has become a mentoring opportunity, and a chance for more experienced musicians to help younger musicians. We also provide our concerts for the public at no charge, and participate in community wide events such as Starlighting, the County Fair, and Ducky Derby. We publicize our performances and invite the public to attend through stories in the News Press and in Your Hub.

Additional Comments: We would like to thank Town Council for their support through grants in prior years. The Band has grown in the last few years. Some of our newest members have recently moved to Castle Rock and are glad to find a local group to perform with. We hope to continue to be the "hometown band" for many years.

I am submitting this grant request for our 2017 Historic Douglas County calendar. HDC decided in January to embark on a five year plan, to develop a 'book calendar' format to record the history of Douglas County. Beginning with the 2016 calendar (copy included), we will break the history of Douglas County into five time segments. The 2016 calendar starts with the Paleo Indians and continues through 1870. The 2017 calendar will move forward from 1870 to 1900. Subsequent issues will take us to the present. We may need to add a sixth calendar, we will not know this until we begin looking closely at the 1940's – 1960's.

HDC has also produced three power point presentations that are related to the history of Douglas County: DC Oakes – Founder of Douglas County, Earth, Wind and Fire, and Breeds, Brands and Ranchers of Douglas County. Our web master, Larry Schlupp, has given the power point presentations to (57) groups in Douglas County, and beyond our borders.

In addition, HDC has developed historical character presentations that are given annually to the following schools: Larkspur Elementary (in conjunction with the Larkspur Historical Society), Franktown Elementary, and Cougar Run Elementary in Highlands Ranch. We provide these programs as educational tools to 2nd – 4th grades. We continue to work with various schools, our goal is to have a historical program in an elementary school in each city / town in Douglas County.

The goal of HDC is to educate the general public in the rich history of Douglas County. Our book calendar project is targeted specifically at how the history of Douglas County is portrayed in our elementary schools. We are hoping that when we complete our five or six volume of calendars, that this will provide our schools with the material to address our history.
