RESOLUTION APPROVING A PIPELINE RIGHT-OF-WAY GRANT WITH CURETON MIDSTREAM, LLC (BOX ELDER PROPERTY, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO)

WHEREAS, as part of its long term water program, the Town purchased the Box Elder Farm property, located in Weld County, Colorado ("Property"); and

WHEREAS, Cureton Midstream, LLC has requested an easement over a portion of the Property to construct a natural gas transmission line; and

WHEREAS, the Town has agreed to grant Cureton Midstream, LLC such easement, and Cureton Midstream, LLC has agreed to compensate the Town in the amount of \$21,163.50 as consideration for the easement; and

WHEREAS, Section 14.02.040.B of the Castle Rock Municipal Code requires Town Council approval of the easement by resolution when compensation or material consideration is received for such easement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval. The Pipeline Right-of-Way Grant in the form attached as *Exhibit 1* is hereby approved. The Mayor and other proper Town officials are hereby authorized to execute the agreement by and on behalf of the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado.
