

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-066**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING A PIPELINE RIGHT-OF-WAY GRANT  
WITH CURETON MIDSTREAM, LLC  
(BOX ELDER PROPERTY, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO)**

**WHEREAS**, as part of its long term water program, the Town purchased the Box Elder Farm property, located in Weld County, Colorado (“Property”); and

**WHEREAS**, Cureton Midstream, LLC has requested an easement over a portion of the Property to construct a natural gas transmission line; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has agreed to grant Cureton Midstream, LLC such easement, and Cureton Midstream, LLC has agreed to compensate the Town in the amount of \$21,163.50 as consideration for the easement; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 14.02.040.B of the Castle Rock Municipal Code requires Town Council approval of the easement by resolution when compensation or material consideration is received for such easement.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Approval.** The Pipeline Right-of-Way Grant in the form attached as *Exhibit 1* is hereby approved. The Mayor and other proper Town officials are hereby authorized to execute the agreement by and on behalf of the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado.
