DISCUSSION / DIRECTION

Redistricting Process

[EC 2018-008](#) **Election Results and Redistricting**

Anderson presented the election results stating that the Mayor at Large election will occur in November 2018 and that the Election Commission is now authorized to redistrict from the current seven districts to six election districts. The Mayor qualifications were also approved by voters.

Amy Hart-Dalton with the GIS department presented four scenarios for the 2018 election districts. They kept the boundaries as close to the original election districts as possible to lessen voter confusion. Additionally, they kept the downtown area and DDA area together that were intuitively connected. All four scenarios are within the required 15% in voter population. Dalton went on to state

they have a scenario builder if the Election Commission would like to make adjustments to the scenarios or create new scenarios.

Election Commission members discussed different aspects of the scenarios they liked and made adjustments to the boundaries which showed live changes to voter populations. The Election Commission asked these changes to be made and to bring back the revised map to the next Commission meeting on June 11 at 6pm for approval pending further changes. They would also welcome feedback from Commissioner Garbo who was unable to attend this meeting.

Dalton stated they would create a similar paper packet for the next meeting and create a separate map that overlays the current seven districts over the new proposed map.
