We, the undersigned, are concerned citizens who urge the Castle Rock Town Council to oppose the current Calvary Church Site Development Plan for the NW corner of Woodlands and 5th St.

Our reasons are as follows:

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2. Reduced safety for neighborhood children.
3. Reduced quality of life.
4. Reduced natural beauty to the Town's Gateway along 5th St.
5. Increased drainage risks in a known, high-risk drainage area due to topography and unpredictable underground streams
6. Reduced property value due to proposed 8'-16' retaining walls (not including a 42" railing on top of the wall). The walls are only 10'-24' from property lines.
