# Council Community Grant Program

On December 02, 2025, Council voted to amend the Council Community Grant Program (CCGP). Please note the following changes in eligibility.

## Previous Requirements

01

Individual grants would cap out at \$1,000 per request with an annual allocation not to exceed \$16,000 for the year or \$4,000 per quarter.

02

Eligible projects contribute to Castle Rock's quality of life, with special emphasis on youth programs and activities, senior programs and activities, and community-based environmental and sustainability programs and activities, and community-based performing and visual arts programs and activities.

03

Preference will be given to applicants who have not received grants previously. Nonprofit organizations may receive only one grant per year.

## Current Requirements

01

Individual grants cap out at \$1,000 per request, with an annual allocation not to exceed \$20,000 for the year, or \$5,000 per quarter.

02

Eligible projects contribute to Castle Rock's quality of life, with special emphasis on youth programs and activities, senior programs and activities, and community-based environmental and sustainability programs and activities, ~~and community-based performing and visual arts programs and activities.~~

03

Preference will be given to organizations located within Castle Rock, as well as to applicants that have not received grants previously.

04

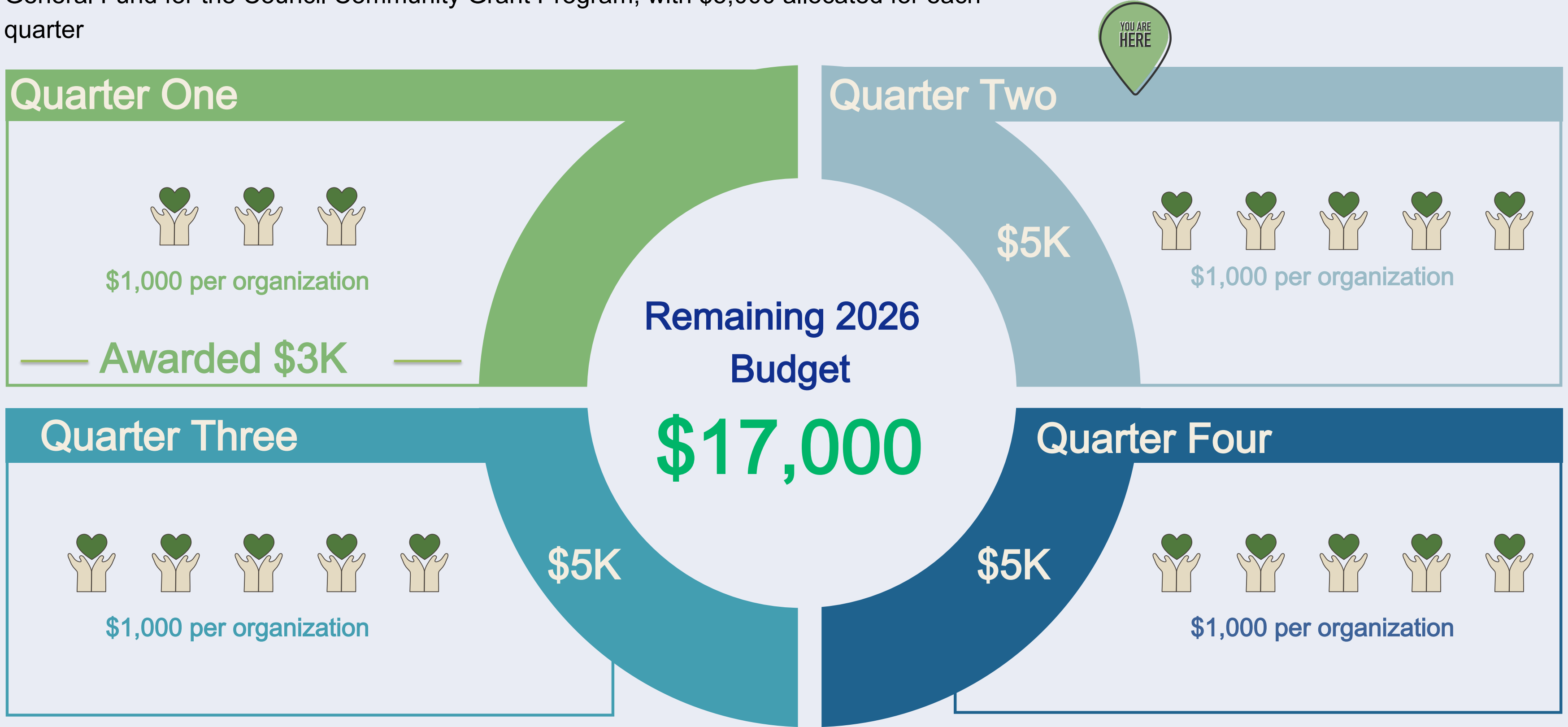
Youth and high school sports/activities are not eligible unless they have an opportunity not repetitive, or a project that uniquely contributes back to the community.

05

Nonprofit organizations may receive only one grant per year. If an organization is awarded a grant two years in a row, it must sit out a year before becoming eligible for future awards

# Overview of Current Budget

The 2026 budget includes \$20,000 in the Town Council Non-Profit Grants account within the General Fund for the Council Community Grant Program, with \$5,000 allocated for each quarter



# Overview of Applicants

The Council Community Grant Program had 3 eligible applicants.

## Castle Country Assisted Living

### Organization

Castle Country Assisted Living is a Castle Rock nonprofit that provides compassionate, home-like assisted living for older adults with varying health and financial needs.

### Purpose of Funds

Funding will enhance Valley House's outdoor therapeutic space with mulch and landscaping improvements, increasing safety, accessibility, comfort, and resident well-being.



Requested: \$1,000

## Agewise Colorado

### Organization

Agewise Colorado is a free nonprofit connecting older adults, caregivers, and families with trusted resources and vetted service providers across Colorado.

### Purpose of Funds

Increase awareness of Agewise Colorado in Castle Rock through targeted outreach, growing local usage from 56 to 100 users per month.



Requested: \$1,000

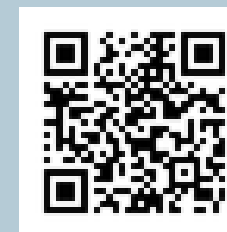
## A Precious Child

### Organization

A Precious Child is a Colorado nonprofit that provides children and families facing poverty or crisis with basic needs, educational support, and opportunities to thrive.

### Purpose of Funds


A Precious Child will serve more than 100 Castle Rock children and caregivers through its Resource Bridge program, providing free essentials, resource navigation, and community distribution events that help families overcome barriers and meet basic needs.



Requested: \$1,000

## Castle Country Assisted Living

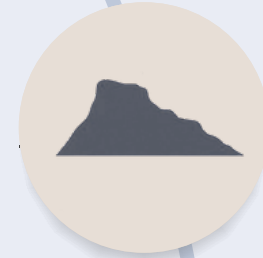

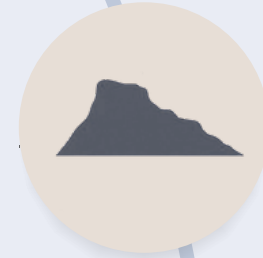

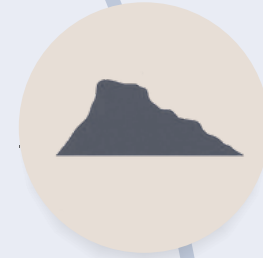
