

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-056

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING DIRECTORS TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF DAWSON TRAILS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 6

WHEREAS, Dawson Trails Metropolitan District No. 6 (the “District”) is a statutory special district located wholly within the boundaries of the Town of Castle Rock (the “Town”); and

WHEREAS, the District operates pursuant to the District’s service plan, including the provision of services and facilities related to water, sewer, storm drainage, and streets; and

WHEREAS, the board of directors for the District is entirely vacant and the District is unable to take any formal action, which has resulted in the interruption of services provided by the District; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is authorized to appoint individuals to a district’s board of directors if the district’s board of directors is entirely vacant and the failure to appoint a new board will result in the interruption of services that are provided by the district, pursuant to §32-1-109(2.5), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has received a petition for appointment to the District’s board of directors from qualified individuals within the District; namely, Lawrence P. Jacobson, Jeffrey Jacob Schroeder, Megan Waldschmidt, Paige Langley and Blake Amen (“Proposed Directors”); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that the appointment of the Proposed Directors will facilitate the District’s compliance with local government laws and allow the District to resume services as contemplated by the District’s service plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Necessity of Appointment. The Town Council determines that failure to appoint qualified individuals to the board of directors for the District will result in the continued interruption of District services and the continued District noncompliance with certain state laws pertaining to local governments.

Section 2. Appointment of Directors. Pursuant to §32-1-905(2.5), C.R.S., the Town Council hereby appoints the following qualified individuals to serve as directors for the District for the terms stated herein:

Lawrence P. Jacobson

Appointed to fill vacancy and to serve until the next election described in paragraph 3 herein for District No. 6.

Jeffrey Jacob Schroeder

Appointed to fill vacancy and to serve until the next election described in paragraph 3 herein for District No. 6.

Megan Waldschmidt

Appointed to fill vacancy and to serve until the next election described in paragraph 3 herein for District No. 6.

Paige Langley

Appointed to fill vacancy and to serve until the next election described in paragraph 3 herein for District No. 6.

Blake Amen

Appointed to fill vacancy and to serve until the next election described in paragraph 3 herein for District No. 6.

Section 3. Election. The District’s board of directors shall hold an election on November 3, 2026, to elect directors pursuant to the Special District Act, Article 1 of Title 32, C.R.S., the Uniform Election Code of 1992, Articles 1 to 13 of Title 1, C.R.S., and the Colorado Local Government Election Code, Article 13.5 of Title 1, C.R.S.
