I think at present you have no choice considering the population increase. I would be concerned about 2 problems considering is this increase in population going to continue? I have never been impressed with consideration of water availability to the greater Castle Rock, Co area. The updated treatment plant and the storage appears to be adequate. I have never seen these facilities except to drive by and that used to be daily. . So in short, I am considering moving back to Castle Rock. We moved for health reasons. Anything you do will not greatly change my future at my elderly age but I am concerned for a town, that I lived in for about 10 years at intervals and my family members still live in to this day. I also have a medical background and health care is important for the community and I usually agree with necessary improvements. I have no current knowledge of your current status in health care. But I have used health care in Castle Rock in the past.

Is there any other information you would like to share?

Not at this time. I just think that unfettered growth in any populated area needs to be done with judicious management and consideration of all resources.
