RESIDENTIAL FIRE SERVICE LINES

CURRENT CODE REQUIREMENT


- Homeowner responsible for maintenance of fire service line
 - Roughly 165 homes with in system
- Inconsistent with domestic service line
- Repairs unlikely, but homeowners not prepared
 - Street work
 - \$4,000 - \$5,000 repair



RESIDENTIAL FIRE SERVICE LINES

GOAL OF NEW ORDINANCE

- Clarify ownership of fire service line
- Make consistent with domestic service
- Ensure integrity of water distribution system
- Place responsibility on experts



RESIDENTIAL FIRE SERVICE LINES

Recommendations

- Staff
- Commission

Budget

- \$4k - \$5k/line; potentially 1 to 2 lines per year
