## Neighborhood Meeting Summary – 544 Senter Drive Neighborhood Meeting #1 – August 31, 2022

What is the purpose of the ADU? Will it be used as an Airbnb? The ADU is for family member use and at this time is not attended to be an Airbnb.

Will there be landscaping? Shrubs will be added to the south side of the property. No grass will be added.

What is considered in allowing an ADU on a property? ADU's that are detached structures are allowed as a Use By Special Review unless they are prohibited by Zoning for the area. Criteria such as setback requirements must be met for an ADU to be approved.

The project is located in Councilmember LaFleur's district. Timing of the formal submittal is not known at this time.
