CURRENT MEMORIAL

Located at Station 155 on Crowfoot Valley Road

Built as part of station construction in 2003

- Not well thought out
- Out of sight, out of mind

Currently have 1 member on Memorial

- FF Rich McConnell died in 1985 after returning from a call

MEMORIAL TEAM

Established team in 2022 to look at current Memorial and make recommendations

Met with Alice Greenwald (ret.), President and CEO of the National September 11th Memorial and Museum in NYC, for direction and guidance

- Based on this meeting, decided to look for alternative site
- Another station, an existing park, downtown?

Decision made to look downtown

Limited space at 151, Festival Park, PSTF

Found potential space at Philip and Jerry Miller Library

PJM LIBRARY

Met with Bob Pasicznyuk, DCL Executive Director

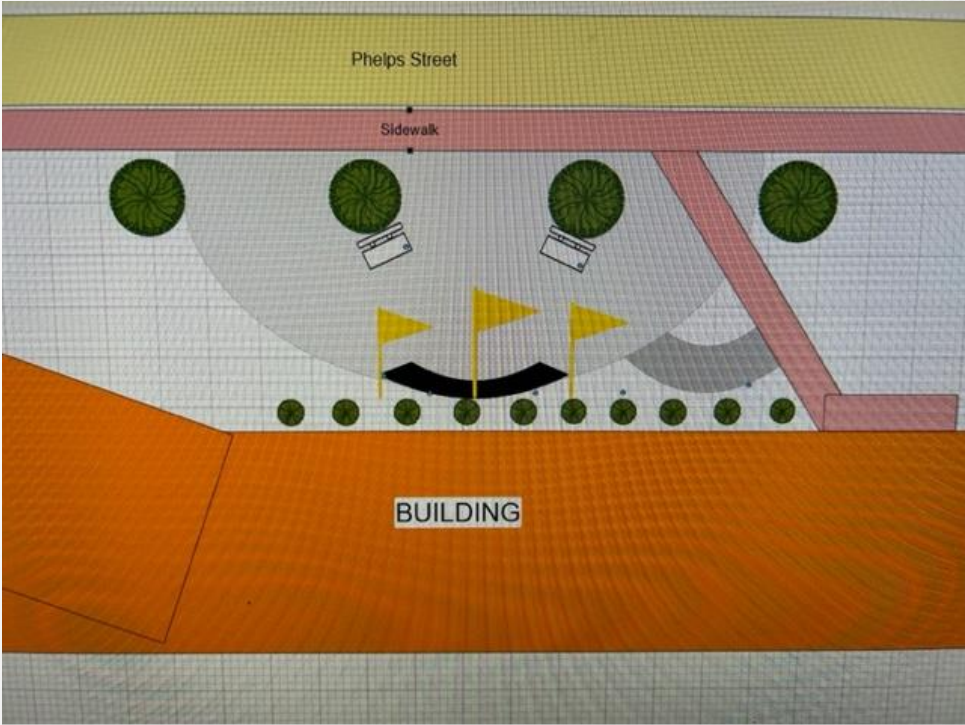
- Explained what we were looking for and why
- Bob was very supportive and put us in touch with his team
- Conducted site visit to look at potential options

Area on north side of library facing Phelps Street determined to be a good location

IGA

Library team willing to work with us on project

Drafted IGA between Town and Douglas County Libraries outlining responsibilities and ownership

DCL Board has approved the IGA to allow for Memorial

- Allows for the construction and maintenance of Memorial
- Other than electricity supplied by DCL, all costs to be borne by the Town
- Will remove turf, but keep existing trees

NEXT STEPS

Town signs IGA

Memorial Team to begin work on design and costs

- Work with DCL and Public Art Commission

Determine method for funding

- Grants, fundraising, private donations, etc.
- No intent to use Town funds

Once funding in place, select designer and contractor to build and install
