A RESOLUTION APPOINTING DAVID J. THROWER AS THE HEARING OFFICER FOR THE LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY AND APPROVING A SERVICE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, according to Section 2.17.010.B of the Castle Rock Municipal Code, the Local Liquor Licensing Authority (the "Authority") for the Town of Castle Rock (the "Town") shall consist of a sole hearing officer who shall serve at the pleasure of the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.17.010.C of the Castle Rock Municipal Code authorizes the Town Council to appoint the presiding judge of the Castle Rock Municipal Court as the hearing officer for the Authority; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2025, the Town Council approved Resolution No. 2025-039 appointing David J. Thrower as the presiding judge; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Town's residents to appoint Judge Thrower to also serve as the hearing officer for the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Appointment of Hearing Officer</u>. The Town Council hereby appoints David J. Thrower as the hearing officer for the Local Liquor Licensing Authority.

Section 2. <u>Approval</u>. The Service Contract between the Town and Judge Thrower is hereby approved in substantially the same form as presented at tonight's meeting, with such technical changes, additions, modifications, deletions, or amendments as the Town Manager may approve upon consultation with the Town Attorney. The Mayor and other proper Town officials are hereby authorized to execute the Service Contract by and on behalf of the Town.

Section 3. <u>Encumbrance and Authorization for Payment</u>. In order to meet the Town's financial obligations under the Agreement, the Town Council authorizes the expenditure and payment in the amount of \$10,000.00, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Town.
